1. As all students enjoy considerable fee subsidy, they will be required to work a minimum of 12 hours per week.
2. Students with genuine financial difficulty may apply to the administration in writing for a work scholarship. Depending upon the availability of fund, a student may be awarded a work scholarship amounting to a maximum of Rs. 10,000 only. They will be required to work an additional 5 - 6 hours per week.
3. Students can also avail "deferred payment" (a monthly payment alternative). For students approved by the administration for deferred payment, please note that:
  - a) Fees are payable on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month.
  - b) A fine of Rs 200 per month will be levied in case of late payment.
